By now, many of you have been flooded with emails from us as we work through several details that need to be addressed to make the event successful. This email will be about Mosaic Shuttles, Volunteers and Balance Due.

## Mosaic Shuttles

August 13<sup>th</sup> will be the deadline for anyone to pay for a Mosaic shuttle as we are trying to make final transportation plans according to the number of people who have paid for the said shuttle. You MUST go into your registration and pay for the Mosaic Shuttle before August 13<sup>th</sup> or find your own way to camp.

### Flight Info/Transportation Plans

WE NEED YOUR FLIGHT INFO for anyone who is using the Mosaic Shuttle. Either go back into the registration system to update your profile or email it to us. It is helpful to you if we have your transportation plans event if you are not using the Mosaic Shuttle. We will then be able to match you with other people traveling at the same time and method as you.

### Airport Captain:

## Packing Party

On Sunday, August 25<sup>th</sup> starting at 2 PM, we will be holding a packing party at the [Allen/Horowitz Residence in Central NJ](#). We take all the documents, badges, give away, and other stuff everyone receives when they arrive at camp and pack them into the participant and leader packets. The process can take several hours pending on the number of people working on the project. We could use a few volunteers to make this happen.
