### We1 Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island

Visit the [Statue of Liberty](#) and [Ellis Island](#) on Statue Cruises from Liberty State Park, NJ. Your cruise ticket will include entry to the [Pedestal](#) and the newly opened [Statue of Liberty Museum](#). Lunch is available at the [Statue of Liberty Café or Ellis Island Café \(pay as you go\)](#). Visitors can take ranger-led or self-guiding tours of Liberty Island. Audio tours that can be used on Liberty Island and Ellis Island are available as part of the ferry ticket.

During the afternoon we'll spend a couple of hours touring the [Museum of Immigration](#) on [Ellis Island](#) that was the point of entry for 12 million immigrants between 1892 – 1954. The National Museum of Immigration has some 30 galleries and exhibits chronicling the history of immigration to the United States.

Highlights include the baggage, registry and hearing rooms of the American Family Immigration Center, a computerized genealogy center.

Patience and understanding are expected. There could be extended wait times to clear security checkpoints. Expect to spend about 3 hours on each island after clearing security. You will need to choose your time wisely.

We'll depart Ellis Island on the 4:25 pm ferry to the Battery to be on time for our evening cruise.

- Cost \$21
- Please bring adequate water, sunscreen, walking shoes, money for lunch, and plenty of patience!
- Two security screenings. Thirty minutes before boarding ferry and 30 to 90 minutes before entering Pedestal.
- No large bags are permitted on the ferry. No backpacks, food and drink, laptops, long umbrellas or tripods are permitted in the pedestal.
- Locker facilities are available for rental at \$2.00 (quarters only). **Bring change!** Locker size dimensions are 12" L x 12" W x 18" D. Lockers are located near the secondary screening building.

### Leader's Responsibilities

- Run the meet the leader meeting on Tuesday evening.
- Meet in the hotel lobby at 6:45 am to walk to Delawanna train station.
- **BE ON TIME! Statue of Liberty is a timed entry venue. We must check-in no later than 9:00 am to clear security before boarding Statue Cruises.** Keep the group together. Arrange for specific meeting points. Allow time for restroom and meal breaks. Suggest appointing a sweep to keep everyone together. Be available by phone to direct anyone who may have fallen behind.
- Suggest handing out slips of paper or business cards to share your name and phone number to your group.
- Be at the Circle Line Ticket Office at Pier 83 on the Hudson River @ W. 43<sup>rd</sup> St by 6:00 pm or you will miss the Cruise for the night.

## Logistics:

**6:00 am – 6:30 am** Breakfast in Breakfast Room next to the lobby

**6:30 am Meet in lobby. Take your train and cruise tickets! It is your responsibility to safeguard your tickets.** These tickets were distributed to you at the Meet the Leader meeting on Tuesday evening.

**6:45 am Depart La Quinta Inn to walk to Delawanna train station.**  
**Walking Directions from Hotel to Train Station (allow 15 minutes)**

1. Walk east from La Quinta Inn parking lot to River Road.
2. Turn left and go north walking under Route 3.
3. After walking one block, River Road becomes Oak Street.
4. Continue walking north on Oak Street for one-half mile to Delawanna Street.
5. Turn right, and you will see steps leading up to the platform for New York and Hoboken trains.

**7:20 am** Depart [Delawanna Train Station](#)

**7:47 am** Arrive Hoboken Transfer to NJ Transit Hudson-Bergen Light Rail

**7:59 am** Depart Hoboken on [Hudson-Bergen Light Rail](#). Take Hudson Bergen Light Rail to Liberty State Park (8 stops). Purchase ticket at ticket vending machine. You **MUST TIME STAMP** all one-way tickets **BEFORE** boarding. To time-stamp, your ticket, insert it into the time stamp machine with the print side up and the NJ Transit logo facing to the left. The machine will date and time stamp your ticket. NJ Transit fare enforcement officers may do random spot checks. Keep your ticket handy until exiting at your destination.

**Walking Directions from Hudson-Bergen Light Rail Station to Statue Cruises**  
**Allow 25 to 30 minutes 1.2 miles**

**8:16 am** Arrive at Liberty State Park Walk one mile to Statue Cruises Dock. Be at the dock at 30 minutes before boarding for security screening.



1. Walk north to Johnston Avenue from Light Rail Station.
2. Turn right on Johnston Avenue.
3. Walk, underneath overpass where the street becomes Audrey Zapp Drive.
4. Turn left and find the path the runs alongside Audrey Zapp Road. Walk for 1 mile along the path.
5. Near the end of the path, you will come to the historic CRRNJ Terminal Building. There will be old train cars to your right and the [Empty Sky: New Jersey September 11<sup>th</sup> Memorial](#). There are port-a-johns for bathrooms near here.
6. Go into the historic terminal building on your right to find the Statue Cruises ticket office. From the ticket office/security tent areas, walk the short walk for departures.

**9:00 am** Arrive at Statue Cruises. Check-In for security screening.

**9:35 am** Statue Cruises departs from Liberty State Park, NJ with a stop at Ellis Island. Stay on boat Arrive at Liberty Island by 10:50 am

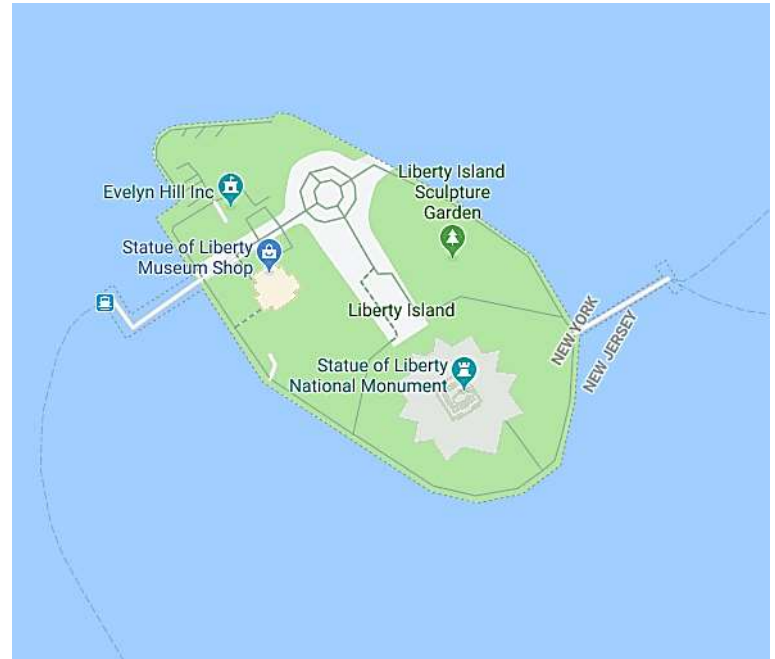

### Statue of Liberty Disembarkation No 1 White Hall Street Station



1. Walk east along with promenade tile you see Staten Island Ferry Terminal. Walk to the northeast side of Staten Island Ferry Terminal to find the No. 1 subway station at Whitehall Street.
2. Take No 1 Train from South Ferry-Whitehall Street Station. Purchase Single Trip MetroCard for \$3. Single Trip MetroCard is Only at vending machines
3. Take No. 1 Local train from South Ferry to Times Square. Stay on local due to rush hour crowds that could potentially separate the group.

### Subway Directions from South Ferry/Whitehall Street to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue & 42<sup>nd</sup> Street Times Square

4. Exit subway and walk to west on W. 42nd Street to Hudson River and turn right. Approximately a twenty-minute walk from the subway station.
5. Walk one block north to Circle Line Ferry Terminal on your left.

**6:00 pm** Meet at Circle Line Ticket window where tickets will Circle Line Harbor Light Cruise tickets will be distributed to the group.
